- (2) An election under subsection (1) shall be conducted by the town clerk or returning officer and shall be done by a secret ballot of councillors. Town Clerk called for nominations for the position of Deputy Mayor.

Councillor Vic Jenkins nominated Councillor Chris O'Grady for the position of Deputy Mayor. Councillor David Kennedy seconded the nomination.
