

Job Ad for Hiking Trail Project

The Town of Carbonear is seeking a Foreperson, one Carpenter and four Labourers for the construction of another phase of the Hiking Trail Project, completing a trail from the West end of Columbus Drive (adjacent to the Recreation Complex) to Knox's Hole as well as miscellaneous clean up of a short trail to London Pond. Applicants for these positions must be receiving E.I. benefits, have received regular E.I. benefits in the last three years or E.I. maternity or parental benefits in the last five years. All Participants will be required to wear steel-nosed safety footwear on site and these must be provided by the participants.

Foreperson: Duties include but are not limited to the following:

Working closely with the Director of Operations and Public Works, the Foreperson will be responsible for the preparation and construction of an approved Walking Trail to Knox's Hole for the Town of Carbonear and for finalizing the necessary clean-up work on the London Pond Trail. The Foreperson is to be able to communicate well and understand the requirements associated with managing a crew of four labourers and a carpenter, and will be responsible for assigning crew duties and site safety measures and other related duties as required. Previous work experience in project leadership and management is an asset.

Carpenter: Duties include but are not limited to the following:

Working under the direction of the Foreperson, the Carpenter will have a good understanding of the basics of carpentry, including the safe operation of small hand and power tools. Some lifting and carrying of project related material is required and participant may also be expected to occasionally work in damp areas underfoot. Work is conducted outdoors and raking, shoveling, and other associated ground work and duties will be necessary in the completion of this project.

Labourers: Duties include, but are not limited to the following:

Working in the outdoors, participants will take direction from the Foreperson. Some lifting, raking, shoveling, and other related ground work and duties will be required in the completion of this project. Participants may also be expected to occasionally work in damp areas underfoot.
