Nell's Walking Trail starts on Pondside Road and the trail continues to Columbus Drive.

Other information includes:

- *Distance: 2.1 km return*
- *Difficulty: Easy*
- *Pet Friendly (Waste bags included)*
- *Parking is located on the side of the road by the trail entrance.*
- *What to wear: Sneakers/active wear.*
- *Blueberry and raspberry bushes located along the trail.*
- *Various flowers located along the trail. Some include buttercups and daisies.*

The trail was dedicated to Nell Finn, first female council member of Carbonear. Finn served the town from 1973-1981.

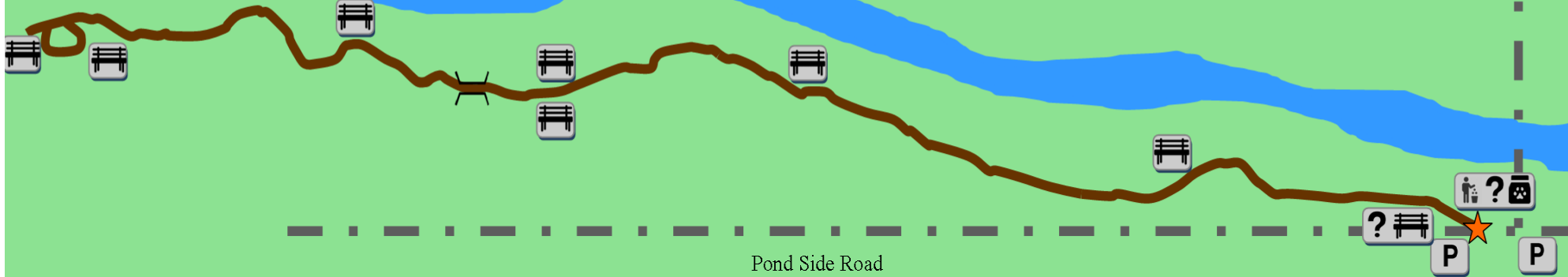
