

INFORMATION ABOUT THE TRAIL

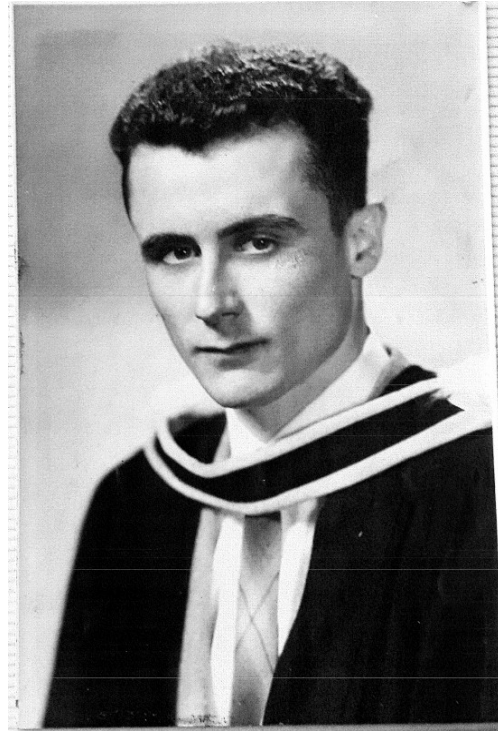
The Carbonear hiking trail can be accessed two ways; off of Columbus Drive or at the end of Nell's Walking Trail where a culvert can be found.

Other information includes:

- *Length: 3 km return*
- *Difficulty: Moderate*
- *Parking: Located at Fong's Motel*
- *What to wear: Active clothing and water resistant shoes/hiking boots.*
- *The trail brings you to Knox's Hole, which is a beautiful area to look over the falls and take a dip*
- *Look out for the fairy houses along the trail!*
