1. Update on Capital Works Projects Highroad South Water and Sewer

The Director of Operations and Public Works advised the following two change orders are requested.

- Change Order #1 in the amount of \$1,097.74 HST included for existing watermain location super positioned with MH7871, cut required and then patched in order to install.
- ➤ Change Order #2 in the amount of \$5,120.26 HST included for a new manhole in order to align with the sewer system.

Marshall Drive Water, Sewer and Street upgrading

The Director of Operations and Public Works provided an update on the project. Discussed concerns from resident of possible washout of gravel driveway where the low back is located. It was noted that this is the same area where the water run off was before the project started, as this the low area in the road.

Director of Operations and Public Works to assess the situation after the next rain fall to determine if there are any concerns.

Valley Road Water, Sewer, and Street Upgrading Phase 3

Councillor Noel declared a conflict of interest on this matter, and his parents and sister have properties in this area.

Deferred to end of meeting.

Former Town Hall Demolition 2.

Director of Operations and Public Works reviewed the details of OHS Division of Service NL involvement on the project. Asbestos was identified at the site and OHS has issued orders to the Town. The Town is complying with the orders from OHS.

The Town asked the contractor to provide a quote for proper remediation of the asbestos. The contractor contacted licensed asbestos abatement companies and received a price from one. The additional cost in the area of \$87,000 + HST. Discussed.

3. Stimulus Project

Town Clerk advised we asked for an extension to defer the project to the spring of 2022. In response, it has been suggested that there is no reason why the Town can't complete the project using the Town's season staff members and avoid the need to try and extend the project beyond its proper closing date. The contractor advised the Town that he is moving forward with work on the project following the original scope of work in the contract.

No changes are being recommended at this time. Work progresses without change to the project at this time. Further discussion to take place with Municipal Affairs regarding traffic consultant and design work.
